



Consumption Data

Munster Simms Engineering Limited (MSEL), as part of our commitment to the environment, strives to reduce energy used and the amount of waste material sent to landfill, in line with our Energy and Waste Minimisation policies.

It is our intention to regularly monitor and improve our environmental performance, through objectives and targets, and to publicly report relevant consumption data, as detailed below:

Energy

The company uses electricity and oil as the main energy sources. In 2008, we used 910025 kWh of electricity and 89709 litres of oil, both down by approximately 10% on the previous year.

Waste

We use recyclable packaging and endeavour to eliminate waste, where possible. Cardboard, paper, pallets, metals and electrical waste are all recycled by the company. General waste is sent for sorting and recycling by a registered waste carrier, with less than 10% going to landfill.

In 2008, the company disposed of approximately 26,000 kgs of general waste, almost 20% less than in 2007.

Packaging

MSEL complies with the Producer Responsibility Obligations (Packaging Waste) Regulations (Northern Ireland). The company used 112,000kgs of packaging materials in 2008, to supply products across the world, which is 3% less than the previous year, despite a significant increase in sales.
